Patients are welcome to bring their carers and translators with them if appropriate.


Patients may be at the clinic for up to an hour and so it would be preferable if no children

The Clinic

This clinic is designed to be clinically effective with a personal service in a friendly, professional and discrete environment. It is a 'one-stop shop' where there will be an ultra-sound scanner available at the appointment plus a consultant able to interpret the results.

Your appointment will be at Whitewater Health in Hook on a Thursday evening. We hope that busy women with many commitments will find it more convenient to attend at this time, rather than at a clinic during the day.

You will be greeted by a receptionist who will explain how the appointment will proceed. There will be a Health Care Assistant to measure your height,



weight and blood pressure and other basic tests, if this information is needed by the Consultant.

If necessary, you will then see the sonographer for an ultrasound scan, if that is appropriate for your condition. After the scan, you will be seen by the Gynaecological Consultant or a GP with specialist knowledge. All patients will have their case discussed with the Consultant Gynaecologist.

A female chaperone will be at the clinic at all times to assist where appropriate.

Mr Christian Phillips, Consultant Gynaecologist. Mr Phillips is a highly respected Consultant at the North Hampshire Hospital and will refer patients to be seen at North Hampshire Hospital if further care is required.
